Carrickmacross Water Supply Augmentation Scheme – Design Build Operate Contract

Restricted Procedure

(Council Directive 2004/17/EC)

Expressions of interest are invited from suitably experienced contractors who wish to tender for works comprising the design, construction, operation and maintenance for a period of up to 20 years of facilities to abstract water from a number of production wells, pumping of the raw water to the new water treatment plant and storing treated water for distribution to the existing distribution network serving the town of Carrickmacross in County Monaghan.

The Project consists of the design and construction and the operation and maintenance for a period of 20 years of a water treatment plant which will ensure an adequate supply of water to Carrickmacross which will comply with the National Drinking Water Regulations, (SI No. 278 of 2007) which gives effect to Council Directive 98/83/EC.

The “operate” element of the contract comprises the operation and maintenance of the designed and constructed facility (including the wells, pumps, rising mains and other existing infrastructure incorporated into the facility) for a period of up to 20 years including replacement of all worn and damaged parts as necessary to keep it in perfect working order.
